On a regular sheet of paper do the following:

**1. List the main characters :**

**2. Tell about the setting (when/where):**

List information concerning the time period (e.g. Early American, ancient times, etc), location (mountains, New Hampshire, Nigeria, etc), and scenery

**3. Tell about the narrator:**

Is the story told from a first-person viewpoint (the person telling the story *is in* the story), or a third-person viewpoint (the author is telling a story about others)

**4. Write one thing you learned from this book:**

You can write something factual such as "Robert E. Lee was a general in the Civil War" or moral such as "A sin always comes to light".
